Treasurer/ Financial Report	Still o/s payment from South Muskoka for 2019/2020 wrap-up; once received we can issue cheques to the centres who need to be reimbursed and close the books for that season

New Business	VP – update from Rep meeting; scheduling October 3; LL scheduling meeting October 6; tryouts after September 27 for U9 and below; tryouts after September 24 for U11 and above; egame sheets; still waiting for decision from Almaguin all other centres have committed; Rep teams to go to a two season schedule; season 1 to end in Mid-January for 20 games; season 2 to go until mid-March with 10 games; referee numbers are unknown until re-certifications are over at the end of September  OMHA – LL can start after September 7; level clinics looking to use online clinic (Levels 1 and 2) with instruction – virtual D1; LL Referees have new price chart; all associations have agreed to fees  Fair Play – Rep will use, not sure about MPS; would like us to use; point system; threshold for penalty minutes; One DB can be set up to factor in Fair Play points; review constitution

## Round Table Discussion

AMHA – registration numbers are down; coaching numbers are down; ice is booked to start for September 7<sup>th</sup>, each team will have 1 ice time per week; when the 2<sup>nd</sup> arena opens then each team will have 2 ice times/week; South River and Sundridge arenas will have the same Covid protocols in place as last season; the league did not have a good experience playing in the northern loop (Health District) last season

Huntsville – registration is still open; no numbers yet but looks promising; dressing rooms will be open; ice times will stay the same; waiving late fees for registration

HS – changing to e-game sheets; numbers are low; 1 LL for each level; have two overage players that require approval to play down; Haliburton is allowing 30 participants on the ice and 50 spectators; referee shortage; may not be able to host a home tournament this season; will be hosting preskates to encourage numbers

PS – no access to dressing rooms; 30 participants per game; 60 spectators per game; registration numbers down; September 7 skate, still finalizing ice times; Bobby Orr arena players need to come dressed; not yet sure of team numbers

SM – numbers are good, currently 3 to 4 teams at each level; schedule September 7 to 24 for clinics; will be unable to follow new Rep schedule for two seasons; all games will be in Gravenhurst and practices in Bracebridge; egame sheets; Fair Play is agreed

VP - n/a

MR – numbers are down; no Midget teams this season; 1 LL team per age division; ice open September 7; all three arenas open but not yet certain of Covid protocol; all practices to be 1 ½ hours; using e-game sheets; dressing rooms open
